

Delivery

Over the 3 year course students are required to attend SRC Portadown one full day per week during term-time and the remaining 4 days will be based at Almac's global headquarters in Craigavon.

Entry Requirements and Application Process

- Have obtained a Level 3 or equivalent qualification equating to 56 UCAS points
- Possess a minimum Grade C in GCSE Mathematics & English (or University approved equivalent)
- Secure employment with an approved employer who will support you through the HLA programme

Please note that these criteria may be further enhanced by Almac and short-listed applicants will also be interviewed by Almac prior to the offer of employment.

Costs

There are no costs incurred as this is funded by the Department for the Economy and the European Social Fund through the HLA programme.

Eligibility

- Candidates should not be currently on any other Government funded training
- Apprenticeship candidates with an HND, Foundation Degree or Degree in a related discipline may not be eligible.
